The Treehouse Store ensures that youth in foster care have access to the items they need to feel confident and ready to learn at school. Youth and their caregivers can shop for new and like-new clothing, school supplies, books, toys, and other essentials at no cost via in-person shopping or online orders.

In-person shopping is open Tuesdays and Thursdays 10 a.m.–4 p.m., Saturdays 10 a.m.–2 p.m., and Wednesdays and Fridays by appointment. Eligible youth can access the store once per month, up to three (3) times per year. For appointments, please contact the Treehouse Store. Treehouse provides funding for youth in foster care to get behind the wheel legally and safely—a crucial aspect to long-term success. Driver's Assistance assists youth accessing driver's education courses, Washington State driver's license and enhanced driver's licenses, basic car repairs and maintenance, vehicle registration fees, and more. Funding requests can be paid directly to the vendor or provided as reimbursements. Payment is not guaranteed until a request has been approved by staff. Educational Advocacy

Treehouse Educational Advocates work with schools, social workers, parents, caregivers, and youth in foster care statewide to resolve difficult issues, remove significant barriers to school success and provide advocacy-related training. Advocates ensure access to education-related support services, aid in a smooth transition during school changes, minimize the effects of school discipline and more. These services are provided remotely through calls, emails, and video conferencing. Available for eligible youth grades K–12 statewide with a referral for a specific and significant educational need.

Treehouse provides one-on-one education planning, coaching, and support to build each youth's engagement in their education and future. This program serves youth in two stages of their journeys:

- Graduation Success Educational Specialists serve students in grades 9–12 as they work toward high school completion and post-high school planning.
- Graduation Success Coaches serve students for 1 year post-high school graduation and focus on short-term goals related to obtaining a degree or credential, a living wage, and stable housing.
